



Volunteer in UMC Copenhagen

The charity organization of the UMC in Copenhagen, called MSA, is looking for two young volunteers willing to work for a year, starting in August or beginning of September 2021.

We will offer you food and accommodation in the heart of Copenhagen and DKK 3000 (approx. 400 €) per month against 37 hours of work per week.

Who are we?

MSA (Metodistkirkens Sociale Arbejde) is a non-profit charity organization situated in the heart of Copenhagen next to the UMC Jerusalemskirken since 1910. We run a café for homeless and vulnerable people who drop in for a light meal, a coffee, a shower and a chat. The café is open all year-round Monday - Friday. During the winter season, we offer free meals to around 50 people on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. MSA also offers supported housing for socially disadvantaged people, runs a dormitory for students, organizes camps and outings, various outreach events, and overall offers practical help for people in need.

Apart from the charity work with socially disadvantaged people, MSA is a property manager who owns buildings in several parts of Denmark.

Job description:

Most of the work will be in the café, and you will help our chef in the kitchen, serve the food and clean up after the meals. Apart from the kitchen work there will also be all kinds of odd jobs helping out in the daily activities of MSA. You will get food and your own room at the dormitory, and DKK 3000 per month. Working hours will be max 37 hours per week and mostly between 8 and 16, however, during winter also on Saturdays and sometimes during evenings. You will be part of the youth organization in Copenhagen and be free to participate in all their activities and camps.

Who are you?

We are looking for preferable 2 young people (18 – 30) who want to spend a gap year in Copenhagen working as volunteers. You speak English, you are able to work independently, and it is an asset if you can cook, but otherwise we will teach you how to cook. Maybe you are a bit of an adventurer who is willing to try all sorts of odd jobs and to learn new skills. Last, but not least, you must be openhearted and have a good sense of humour.
